Lake Chabot Boating Rules and Regulations

- All boats are required to have a boat permit *before* launching boat into the lake.
- Boat Ramp Summer Hours: 9:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m. April September Off Season Hours: 9:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- Boating permit and valid ID required at all times
- No gasoline engines allowed on boat, boats with inboard engines are strictly prohibited from operation on the lake per City of Vallejo Master Lease
- No boating after sunset
- All persons using lake for any boating activity is required to wear a Coast Guard Approved life jacket.
- Boaters may not access shore anywhere except the boat ramp in Dan Foley Park
- Violation of these rules will result in loss of your boating privileges
- To report emergency accidents Call 911
- Please note: Six Flags and GVRD share this lake and boating is only permitted on half of the lake, on the Dan Foley Park side. Boats crossing the midline of the lake towards Six Flags are considered to be tresspassing.
