Project Background

The City applied for and was awarded a \$4.7M Clean CA Local Grant by the State of CA. The project will beautify Lake Dalwigk Park and enhance community connections from the surrounding neighborhoods into the park.

The project stakeholders include:

City of Vallejo Public Works Department Greater Vallejo Recreation District (GVRD) Vallejo Flood & Wastewater District (VFWD)







The project will include cleanup efforts, new restroom, ADA improvements, landscaping, art pieces, digital education and a ribbon-cutting ceremony.

Project Improvements



- 3.8 acres of drought-tolerant landscaping
- Sidewalk replacement
- ADA access improvements
- Prefabricated restroom
- Shade structure, Picnic Tables, trash cans, dog waste stations, & drinking fountains
- 2 monument signs
- LED lighting throughout the park
- Paved multi-modal path w/connection to Curtola Park & Ride facility
- Restored bridge
- Lemon Street improvements
- Traffic circle
- Decorative crosswalks
- Interpretive signage, educational program, Litter abatement events


