Agreement, Waiver & Release

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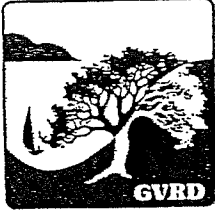

CODE OF CONDUCT

The following is a guide for our staff to use to help determine appropriate discipline for student behavior issues.

1. Disobedience (refusing to listen or follow instructions)	1 st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel & parent notified. 2 nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 1-3 day suspension & parent notified. 3 rd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent conference required. 4 th Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required.
2. Disruptive Behavior (behavior that interferes with or prohibits others from hosting or participating in the program)	1 st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel & parent notified. 2 nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 1-3 day suspension & parent notified. 3 rd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent conference required. 4 th Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required.
3. Profanity (cursing or using inappropriate language)	1 st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel & parent notified. 2 nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 1-3 day suspension & parent notified. 3 rd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent conference required. 4 th Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required.
4. Vandalism (damaging facilities or property of others)	1 st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent notified or conference required. 2 nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required. 3 rd Offense: Expulsion from program / parent conference required. *Please Note: Law enforcement may be notified on any of the above offenses as deemed appropriate by Recreation Staff.
5. Theft (stealing from school, staff or other students)	1 st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent notified or conference required. 2 nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required. 3 rd Offense: Expulsion from program / parent conference required. *Please Note: Law enforcement may be notified on any of the above offenses as deemed appropriate by Recreation Staff.
6. Verbal threatening of another child or employee (statement of intent to cause harm)	1 st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent notified or conference required. 2 nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required. 3 rd Offense: Expulsion from program / parent conference required. *Please Note: Law enforcement may be notified on any of the above offenses as deemed appropriate by Recreation Staff.

Sexual harassment (repeated unwelcome verbal, visual, or physical sexual advances)</p>	<p>1st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with a 3-5 day suspension & parent notified or conference required. 2nd Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required. 3rd Offense: Expulsion from program / parent conference required.</p> <p>*Please Note: Law enforcement may be notified on any of the above offenses as deemed appropriate by Recreation Staff</p>

Use or possession of weapons</p>	<p>1st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required. 2nd Offense: Expulsion from program / parent conference required.</p> <p>*Please Note: Law enforcement may be notified on any of the above offenses as deemed appropriate by Recreation Staff</p>

Use or possession of drugs, alcohol or tobacco</p>	<p>1st Offense: Time-out/in, loss of privileges, staff counsel, behavior notice with 5-30 day suspension or expulsion & parent conference required. 2nd Offense: Expulsion from program / parent conference required.</p> <p>*Please Note: Law enforcement may be notified on any of the above offenses as deemed appropriate by Recreation Staff</p>
